

## An Evaluation of the Dorothy M. Wylie Nursing Leadership Institute

### *Why are we evaluating the DMW-NLI?*

This evaluation will help us understand the extent to which the DMW-NLI influences leadership practices among nurses. This is one of the first long-term evaluations of participants in nursing leadership institutes. Results will be used to improve the DMW-NLI & may inform policy decisions in regards to nursing leadership development. This research will help assure that the DMW-NLI evolves in the best possible way to serve the country's future nurse leaders.

### *What's being evaluated?*

This survey asks for their feedback on the extent to which the DMW-NLI realized its goals & explores whether DMW-NLI alumnae report changes in leadership practices & career paths over three years. The evaluation is led by Linda O'Brien-Pallas, CHSRF/CIHR Chair in Nursing Human Resources & Co-Director of the Nursing Health Services Research Unit, University of Toronto site.
